Entries will be accepted on a FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED basis. The closing date for entries 11:59pm Wednesday 6th September 2023 or WHEN FULL* if earlier than this date.

*The meet will be deemed full when the session time reaches 3.5 hours

A list of processed entries will be published on 18th September 2023. Competitors are requested to check their entries carefully and inform <u>meetmanager@cityofmanchesterswimteam.co.uk</u> immediately of any errors.

The promoter strongly recommends that no travel arrangements are confirmed until the club receives a written confirmation of accepted entry.

Poolside Passes

Cost per pass = £15 per day*.

Clubs must adhere to Swim England's supervision ratio policy, more information can be found: https://www.swimming.org/swimengland/swim-england-relases-supervision-ratios-policy/

All Coaches, Chaperones and team staff must be in possession of a poolside pass to access the event. This must be worn at all times in the venue. It is mandatory that anyone applying for a poolside pass must have a valid and in

date DBS, safeguarding training in line with Wavepower (2020-2023) and appropriate qualifications. Chaperones for para swimmers are to be on a 1:1 basis.

*Any team that attends the meet and provides at least one technical official for both of the 2 sessions will be entitled to one, 1-day poolside pass for the Meet. In this case please still complete a poolside pass request and make this clear on the form.

COVID-19 Information

Competitors, Spectators and all those in possession of a poolside pass are to follow the policies and procedures of the event which may include COVID-19 protocols which are dependent on the Government (National and Local), or Swim England or facility guidelines at the time. Further information will be provided closer to the event.

Draft Programme

The draft programme will be posted on the City of Manchester Aquatics Swim Team website (<u>http://cityofmanchesterswimteam.co.uk</u>) as soon as possible after the closing date for the competition. This will include estimated session start times.

Withdrawals

Notification of a withdrawal from a heat must be made no later than one hour before the advertised start time of the relevant session, in line with the Event conditions, can be made in the following ways:

- 1. In person by completing an official withdrawal form (available at the Sport Information Desk)

All withdrawals must state NAME, CLUB, EVENT NUMBER, EVENT, COMPETITOR NUMBER.

Warm Up & Swim Down

The competition pool will be available for warm up ahead of sessions. Afternoon warm up times will be provided closer to the event.

The diving pool will be made available at the start of the session and available throughout the competition.

Para Swimmers

The Meet Management Group will seek to appoint an official who has completed Disability swimming training.

Subject to it operating correctly there will be a secondary start strobe available for use on request of athletes.

Call Room

Swimmers must report to the Call Room 'race ready' and in sufficient time and be available to parade for their

event.

Coaches and Team Staff will not be allowed to enter the Call Room.

Spectator Information

Current plans are for spectators to be allowed into the event. This will be confirmed closer to the event day.

Spectators passes will be available for purchase from the front desk on the day of the event, at the following prices:

- One session £5
- All day £10

Anyone wishing to take still or digital photography (including using mobile phones to do this) must do so in accordance with Swim England Photography Guidance (see Wavepower 2020-2023). Flash photography is strictly prohibited at all times.

Refunds

Refunds will only be given where:

• Entrants have been rejected by the Competition organiser where conditions were adhered to, but rejection is based upon time constraints, then refunds will automatically processed for each rejected event following the completion of the event.

• Competitors who have withdrawn from events due to either a medical reason or injury once appropriate evidence (e.g. a note from a doctor or physio) has been submitted to the following email address: meetmanager@cityofmanchester.co.uk. Withdrawing from the event must be completed prior to the event/session in which the individual is due to compete. Any failure to withdraw or notification of withdrawal received later than the event withdrawal cut off time will result in no refund being processed.

Refunds will **not** be given for the following:

- Any entries rejected due to non-compliance of competition conditions
